Driving to and from Cathedral Academy is a privilege that carries with it a great responsibility. Please read through the following list. These simple rules allow us to ensure safety for those driving, as well as those walking on campus.

1. Student drivers must register their vehicles with the school office by completing this form and placing the original with Mrs. Vetter in Guidance. A photocopy of the student's license, registration, and insurance information must accompany this form.
2. Student drivers may transport other students from home to school in the mornings only with written permission from all parents involved.
3. Student drivers may transport other students from school to their home after school dismissal, only with written permission from all parents involved.
4. Student drivers may drive from school to a school competition, athletic, academic, or otherwise. Student athletes and competitors travel as a team at the coach's discretion.
5. Student drivers may not drive to field trips. All students must ride with a Cathedral Academy approved adult driver.
6. Student drivers may not transport any other student, other than a sibling, from school to a school function, athletic, academic, or otherwise.
7. Student drivers must park their vehicles in the gravel lot next to the soccer field. Once parked, the vehicle should be locked and may not be visited until dismissal.
8. Student drivers must follow all Cathedral Academy traffic patterns in the morning and for dismissal. The speed limit on campus is 7 mph.
9. Student drivers who are scheduled for early dismissal must leave campus upon dismissal. Student drivers may not stay on campus unsupervised.
10. All vehicles parked on campus are subject to search at the discretion of the administration.
11. Student drivers are expected to represent Cathedral Academy in an appropriate manner when operating their vehicles off campus, as well, as they are representing Cathedral Academy in the community. Cathedral Academy students are expected to represent themselves and the school in a Godly manner 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, 365 days per year. (24/7/365)
12. Student drivers who violate school policy and policies listed on this contract will have their driving privilege suspended and/or revoked.
